Dr. Salomon completed the Biochemistry career at the University of Córdoba, Argentina, in 1977 and got his PhD degree at the University of Buenos Aires in 1989. He has been the Director of INBIRS UBA-CONICET, the Institute for Biomedical Research on Retroviruses and AIDS – Univ. of Buenos Aires – Natl Research Council (former Argentinean National Reference Center for AIDS – CNRS) since 2000.

He served as Associate Investigator for CONICET (National Research Council) from 1999 to 2003 and now he holds a Principal Investigator position. From 1992 to 1995, he performed his Post-Doctoral Fellowship at the Jewish General Hospital, Lady Davis Institute, McGill University, AIDS Center in Montreal, Canada.

Since 1997, he has served as Professor for the Department of Microbiology, Sch of Medicine, University of Buenos Aires. Since 2003, he has been a member of the Examination Board of Microbiology at the School of Medicine, University of Buenos Aires. He has also served as Chair of different workshops and Conferences on Virology.

He published his research works on HIV/AIDS (144) in several national and international journals such as: JAIDS, J Med Virol; Journal of Infectious Diseases, AIDS, J. Clin Microbiol, Science, Nucleosides & Nucleotides, J. Acquir Immune Defic Synd and Hum Retrovirol, Antiviral Therapy, Aids Research and Human Retroviruses, Journal of Virology, HIV Medicine, Clin Infect Dis, Int J Epidemiol, etc.

Dr. Salomon has been granted several awards on his experience on HIV/AIDS. As the Principal Investigator of several research projects, he received grants from NIH, UNAIDS, and from some Argentinean institutions.

He has been the Director of Theses (MSc and PhD) and of Investigators from CONICET, PhD Board of Examination at the University of Buenos Aires; Reviewer of Scholarships and Grants. He has also been involved in the organization and direction of Conferences, Symposia, Meetings and Reviewer of Scientific Journals such as AIDS Research and Human Retroviruses. He also served as Co-Chair of the 1st IAS Conference on HIV Pathogenesis and Treatment.
