



IAS Membership Contest Terms and Conditions

Participation in the International AIDS Society membership contest is free and does not depend on the purchase of or claim on non-gratuitous services. The participant does not enter into any contractual or other legal relationship with the International AIDS Society or third parties. Persons entering this competition must be of full age and of legal capacity. Employees of the International AIDS Society, as well as their family members, and agencies of the International AIDS Society are excluded from participation. By entering the competition, the entrant expresses agreement with the rules of the contest:

1. Privacy

The International AIDS Society points out that, without explicit consent of the participant, personal data (including email addresses, names, addresses, etc.) of the participant will not be passed on to or left for use of third parties. One exception is in case of a win, in which case the participant expressly allows the International AIDS Society to publish his or her name and place of residence. The participant, by entering the competition, expressly allows the International AIDS Society to save his or her e-mail address and use it for statistical and advertising purposes.

2. Eligibility

To be eligible for the draw, contestants must enter the contest by completing the registration form. This information is automatically sent to the International AIDS Society. Participants can only win one prize.

3. Determination and notification of winners

Winners are picked at random. The winners are picked from all those taking part. Winners will receive a separate e-mail informing them of their win.

4. Redemption of prizes

The prize will be transferred exclusively to winners or their legal representatives if they are underage. The prize is awarded exclusively in the form of a two-year IAS membership. No material or cash alternative prizes can be issued. The prize will be automatically issued to the selected email address by the International AIDS Society. The winner is himself/herself responsible for any taxation associated with the prize. The validity cannot be extended.

5. Disqualification from the prize draw

The International AIDS Society reserves the right to disqualify individual participants from the prize draw if there are justifiable grounds, e.g. infringement of the rules of participation, influencing the draw, manipulation, etc.

6. Legal action

No correspondence will be entered into about the competition. The judges' decision is final. No claims can be made relating to the forwarding, redemption or exchange of prizes. Swiss law shall apply exclusively.

7. Changes to the rules of participation and termination of the prize draw

The International AIDS Society reserves the right to modify the conditions of the draw at any time. Furthermore, the International AIDS Society reserves the right to terminate or interrupt the prize draw at any time. This especially applies in the event of the existence of grounds that would interfere with or prevent the running of the prize draw according to plan.

8. Liability limitations

As long as legally allowed, the liability of any kind of the International AIDS Society is excluded.
