

U.S. became epicenter of pandemic on March 26 and highest # of deaths on April 11 (highest in New York) Now 792,938 cases (out of 2.48 million)/42,518 deaths

Clinical Characteristics of Covid-19 in New York City

- 1st 393 patients (62.2; 61% male; 36% obesity)
- Cough (79.4%), fever (77.1%), dyspnea (56.5%), myalgias (23.8%), diarrhea (23.7%), and nausea and vomiting (19.1%)
- 90% lymphopenia, 27% thrombocytopenia, and many had elevated liver-function values and inflammatory markers
- 33.1% intubated (33.1% of those eventually extubated); 10.2% died
- Obesity (>30 BMI) main risk factor for severe disease



The Pandemic's Hidden Victims: Sick or Dying, but Not From the Virus

As the coronavirus overwhelms the health care system, people with other illnesses struggle to find treatment.

Impact of HIV on COVID

Worse outcomes?

Distancing from clinics, ART refills, more immunosuppression, can't shelter in place, high risk of comorbidities in HIV

Better outcomes

Less immune inflammation response; TAF and TDF phosphorylated may have activity against RNA pol; LPV/r and now ATV may have activity against SARS-CoV-2 protease

- "Surge" ID team means RNs/SWs playing huge role with patients- Outreach project + telehealth project


