

Strategic Focus of the HIV response



RIASOverview of the HIV resposne



- 1,700,000 PLHIV (1,600,000 are adults aged 15+)
- 63% of the PLHIV are Women adults
- o 5.5% of the PLHIV are children <15 years
 </p>
- HIV incidence estimated at 0.96 per 1000 uninfected people
- 54,000 people were newly infected with HIV
- 62.2% of the new HIV infections were among women adults
- 28% of the new HIV infections were among young people (15-24 years)
- Young women (15-24 years) accounted for 73% of all the new HIV infections among young people
- o Final vertical transmission rate including during breastfeeding is at 10.89%






New HIV infections (UNAIDS 2022 estimates)








Final vertical transmission of HIV (UNAIDS 2022 estimates)



XIAS HIV Prevalence by region (THIS 2016-17)











HIV Prevalence among KVPs (IBBS 2017, CUHAS 2018)

XIAS The 90 90 90 achievements, 2021 (UNAIDS 2022 estimates)



97% were on treatment; Of these

97% had suppressed viral load





Progress on ART

- Approximately 1.5m PLHIV were on treatment (88.2%)
- o 64.3% of PLHIV on HIV treatment were women
- 93% of adult women living with HIV were on treatment compared to 77% of adult men.
- 60% of children aged 0-14 years living with HIV were on treatment
- 79.7% of pregnant women living with HIV accessed ARVs for PMTCT
- MTCT rates 10.9% at the end of breastfeeding






Treatment cascade for Women 15+ (UNAIDS 2022 estimates)







Treatment cascade for Men 15+ (UNAIDS 2022 estimates)








Treatment cascade for Children <15 years (UNAIDS estimates 2022)



- 28,797 deaths among PLHIV
- o 52% of the AIDS related deaths were among men
- 21.3% of the AIDS related deaths among children <15 years
- o 80% of AIDS related deaths among all children were among <5

Current key challenges

- High levels of new HIV infections among AGY
- Low comprehensive knowledge among AGY (36.7% THIS 2016-17)
- Low condom use at high risk sex (31.7% THIS 2016-17), MSM 14%, FSW 71%
- HIV domestic funding is less than 10%
- High MTCT at 10.9%
- Sub-optimal coverage of HEID (68% at 2 months)
- High level of discriminatory attitude 25.6% (THIS 2016-17)
- Some populations are left behind in achieving the 90 90 90 targets
- -(Fisherfolks, people in the transport corridors-TISINI study)
- -Children 60 60 55
- -Men 85 77 75
